Thursday 22.12.1748		Robert Watson	William Hall free by Patrimony and excused paying Father's Quarterage arrears, as he had died insolvent.
Thursday 23.3.1749		~	Samuel Chorley (Court) had died.
Thursday 22.6.1749		~	John Nelson elected Court and sworn.
Thursday 28.9.1749	The George in Ironmonger Lane	John Cotterell	Elected & sworn: John Cotterell (M) Jonathan Clarke (UW) and Thomas Ockelshaw (RW).
Sunday 17.12.1749		~	John Croshaw (Court) had died. Frederick Stanton advised the Court that 2 Assistants of the Clockmakers Co wished to inspect the Charter, By- laws and books and take copies as precedents for a new Livery Co - Deferred. The £200 Bond from Croshaw & Blake to Maydwell & Newman being lost, John Blake desired to pay in the sum + interest. Clerk had drafted a release which was to be engrossed and sealed on receipt of the money due.
Wed'day 10.1.1750		~	Although the Bond totalled £210.18.7d, Court accepted £209.5.10 in full settlement and indemnity released. Court agreed to buy £200 3% Annuities for the Company.
Thursday 22.3.1750		~	Advise Anthony Scarlett elected to Court. £200 Annuities had been purchased and transferred to Fred Stanton for the Co.
Thursday 21.6.1750		~	Anthony Scarlett sworn Court.
Thursday 27.9.1750	The George in Ironmonger Lane	Thos. Ockelshaw	Elected & sworn: Thomas Ockelshaw (M) James Turner (UW) & Anthony Scarlett (RW). Assistant John Nelson was ill and asked to fine all offices. Finally agreed at £16 & remain on Court.
Thursday 20.12.1750		~	Herman Mackelcan (Court) had died. Master advised Court that the Beadle Robert Pluckrose had gone to Antigua on some extraordinary business and would take it a great favour if they would permit William Stafford to officiate in his room until he returns and to receive his salary and fees. The Court agreed.
Thursday 21.3.1751		~	Advise Philip Margas elected Court in place H. Mackelcan.
Thursday 20.6.1751		~	Philip Margas excused Court but fined £16. Advise James Elliott elected Court.
Thursday 26.9.1751	The George in Ironmonger Lane	Anthony Scarlett	Frederick Stanton acted for Master. James Elliott sworn Court.
Thursday 19.12.1751		~	Elected & sworn: A Scarlett (M), Wm Ferrian (UW) J Elliott (RW). £50 3% Consols 1743 to be purchased by RW. Thomas Ockelshaw (Court) had died. Benefactors' names to be written on tables.
Thursday 19.3.1752		~	George Nail fined for not accepting Court. Robert Watson (Court) had died. James Elliott had bought £50 3% Consols 1743 for Co.
Thursday 12.6.1752		~	Frederick Stanton acted for Master. Richard Ricards and John Scrivener elected Court for Thos. Ockelshaw and Robt. Watson.
Thursday 28.9.1752	The George in Ironmonger Lane	James Elliott	Frederick Stanton acted for Master. Richard Ricards & John Scrivener both sworn Court. Elections: James Elliott (M), James Abiss (UW) & Richard Ricards (RW). Advise James Abiss elected.

Thursday 21.6.1753		~	Advise John Garrett elected Court. Robert Pluckrose absent for 2 years to attend next Court or be discharged.
Thursday 27.9.1753	The George in Ironmonger Lane	~	Beadle Robert Pluckrose discharged. Replace next Court. John Garrett sworn Court. Elected R.Ricards (M) Richard Farrar (UW) & John Scrivener (RW). Wardens sworn in.

Names M & W's 1753 to date to be added to Table. Isaac Akerman advised father John Akerman (Court) had died.
Thursday 15.12.1757		~	Advise Bernard Hillebrant elected Court. Company Seal affixed to letter of Attorney for Joseph Cartony to receive dividends on £250 3% Consols. Clerk to provide Mahogany Box lined with a green baize with a good lock, 2 keys and 2 brass handles, to keep the Company's books in.
